Stanley Gardner - male, 20-40 John’s upstairs neighbor and best friend.

Detective Sergeant Troughton - male, 20-30 young officer, severe and very by-the-book.

Detective Sergeant Porterhouse - male, 40-60 middle-aged officer who has “seen it all”.

Bobby Franklin - male, 20-50 A flamboyant dress designer who just moved in upstairs.

Newspaper Reporter - male or female, any age. Pushy. (Will double as ASM if interested)
