both understand and agree that we will comply with all the following Covid-19 pro	tocols for all rehearsals and shows
throughout the entire production at Playhouse 1960.	
1. If I or a household member has had a known exposure to Covid-19, I wi	ill notify the director and not attend
rehearsals/shows until I have met current CDC quarantine guidelines. If I test positive for Covid-19, I will notify the director	
and not attend rehearsals or shows until I have met current CDC isolation guideline	es.
2. I will wear a mask, that follows current CDC guidelines, at all times at re	ehearsals and shows. My mask must
completely cover my nose and mouth, be made from materials that are at least 2 $\ensuremath{\text{l}}$	ayers thick, are not made from loosely
knit together fabric or mesh type fabric, is well-fitted around all 4 sides of the masl	k (no gaping around cheeks, nose, or
chin), is NOT a gaiter or other single-layer fabric that loosely fits around chin, and c	does NOT have any type of valve or vents.
Non-medical surgical-style masks or homemade masks made from 2 or more layers	s of cotton fabric are ideal.
3. I will not gather in lobby/foyer/backstage/dressing rooms during, before	re, or after rehearsals. Ideally, everyone
should be masked and maintaining a 6-ft distance from anyone not from the same	household at all times.
4. Food should not be consumed at rehearsals, please eat before arriving.	. Masks may not be removed to eat
during rehearsals. When drinking water, please be sure you are 6ft from others, re	move your mask, drink the water, and
place your mask back on. Do not walk around maskless while slowly drinking water	r. If you want to step out onto the front
porch for a longer water break (or you need a break from your mask), you can rem	ove your mask once you are outside, but
you still need to remain 6 feet from others while doing so.	
5. When blocking or rehearsing music, I will remain where I was assigned	to sit and not relocate until instructed to
do so. This will help all cast members to remain 6 ft from others during rehearsals.	
6. Parents, siblings, or other non-cast/crew are not allowed to attend rehe	
days for parents, the work will be done outdoors in the parking lot to give plenty of space. If weather does not permit	
outdoor set build days, we will limit the number of volunteers to allow for 6ft distance between work stations. Cast	
members should be dropped off and picked up from the front door area. Questions for the directing team should be sent	
via email or Facebook messenger to limit interactions before and after every rehearsal between parents and the directing	
team.	
7. Throughout rehearsals, anytime I remove/re-apply my mask to drink w	
thoroughly wash my hands or use the provided hand sanitizer. Hand sanitizing stat	ions are found throughout the theatre
and sinks/soap are located in all 3 restrooms.	
8. I understand that my guests must wear a mask at all times when attended	
wearing a mask, or removing it during the show, will be asked to leave the perform	nance. Tickets will not be refunded to a
guest removed due to refusal to follow mask guidelines.	
9. I understand that if I am found not following any of the above Covid-19	
but upon the second offense, I will be sent home from rehearsal. After being sent I	
not following another protocol, I will be removed from the production. Cast memb	pers removed for not following Covid-19
protocols will not be refunded production fees.
